



The following declaration constitutes your enrollment in this Concentration and will be placed in your official student records. Please return completed form to the Registration Office.

To obtain the Concentration in Entertainment and Media Law, students must take at least 15 units of Core and Elective courses. A student who completes the requirements for the Concentration will receive a "Concentration in Entertainment and Media Law" designation on their transcript. A student with at least 10 graded units of Core and Elective courses, and a Concentration GPA of 3.33 or higher will receive a "Concentration in Entertainment Law with Honors" designation on their transcript.

The Concentration GPA will be calculated at the time of graduation. Every graded course a student has taken from the Core and Elective course listing will be included in the Concentration GPA and weighted in accordance with the number of units assigned to that course.

Not all courses are offered every year, and students must meet all course prerequisites and requirements. This Concentration does not change any course prerequisites.

To satisfy the Core Course requirement, students must complete the following: (1) Copyright Law; (2) at least one Foundational course (Entertainment Law, Mass Media Law, or Trademark Law); (3) at least one Externship in entertainment or media law totaling a minimum of 3 units; and (4) at least one Clinic or Skills course for totaling a minimum of 2 units.

To the extent that the required 15 units for the Concentration are not satisfied by a student taking additional Core courses beyond the required units, students must satisfy the Concentration's required units through Elective courses.
