## B. Communicating Under This Policy

# 3. Examplify is unavailable and Southwestern's campus is closed due to an emergency

If Examplify is unavailable and Southwestern's campus is closed due to an emergency, all students will complete their examinations remotely. The examination will be administered as an open-book, open-note take-home examination. The administration will follow the process outlined in Section C.

A professor may change the examination's composition from that previously announced to the class (e.g., an examination originally planned to include essays and multiple-choice questions may change to only essay questions or include fewer multiple-choice questions) and impose a word or page limit.

For students who complete examinations on Southwestern-

#### 1. ProctorU is unavailable

If ProctorU is not available, students will complete their examinations using Examplify with ExamID and ExamMonitor. Southwestern may also make any of the following accommodations:

Southwestern may work with the professor to change the examination's composition (e.g., an examination originally planned to include essays and multiple-choice questions may change to only essay questions or include fewer multiple-choice questions) or may convert the examination, reschedule the examination, or take other steps that are fair and equitable to those who may have already taken the examination and those who must still take the examination.

The examination may be administered as an open-book, open-note take-home examination. "Take-home" means an examination is not proctored. The examination will become available on Canvas, Southwestern's Learning Management System, at the regularly scheduled examination time and will be available for the originally planned duration (e.g., three hours).

### 2. Examplify is unavailable

If Examplify is not available, Southwestern may make any of the following accommodations:

Southwestern may work with the professor to change the examination's composition (e.g., an examination originally planned to include essays and multiple-choice questions may change to only essay questions or include fewer multiple-choice questions) or may convert the examination, reschedule the examination, or take other steps that are fair and equitable to those who may have already taken the examination and those who must still take the examination.

The examination may be administered as an open-book, open-note take-home examination. "Take-home" means an examination is not proctored. The examination will become available on Canvas, Southwestern's Learning Management System, at the regularly scheduled examination time and will be available for the originally planned duration (e.g., three hours).

Southwestern will release the examination on the Exam Administration Canvas course. Students will complete the examination in Canvas and submit their completed examination through the Exam Administration Canvas course. Students must begin the exam during the scheduled or rescheduled examination window. Canvas will track each student's examination time and end the exam after the examination duration has elapsed.
